Year 11 qualifications and grades

Following the release of further detail this afternoon about how grades will be awarded, we will be seeking clarification on a number of matters. I politely ask you to refrain from emailing us over the weekend, we will be in touch early next week.

Home Learning Programme

As promised on Wednesday, I attach a document with details of the Home Learning Programme for Years 7-10.

We have been collecting together all the **exercise books of students in Year 7-10** and they have been bundled together by student. If you are able to collect them safely, then you or someone you have authorised may pick up the books during normal school hours from Monday. Having the exercise books provides another source of knowledge and information for students.

We have put together packs of work for those without internet/PC access which we will be distributing early next week.

KLB School closed

From Monday, only those students who are eligible to attend will be allowed on site. We can only provide safe supervision for a very limited number of children and so it is important that I re-emphasise my message from earlier today. **At this vital stage of limiting the spread of COVID-19 it is imperative that children stay home wherever possible. KLB is not in the position to supervise students unless the parents' work is critical and students cannot be safely supervised.** For those students attending we will be open from 8am until 4pm. Students should head to the canteen between 8am and 8.30am where breakfast will be available to purchase. We will be starting the day officially at 8.30am. Students can be picked up at the normal time of 2.45pm or at 4pm. Please contact the bus companies directly for information about whether your route is operating.

This has certainly been an unusual week but as it draws to a close, I would like to thank all of my colleagues at KLB who have done a brilliant job in such uncertain times. We will continue to support you and your children over the coming weeks and months albeit, for the vast majority, from a distance.
