Dear Parents and Carers,

Following the announcements yesterday, we are still awaiting further detail from the government about how qualifications and examination grades will be awarded. We will keep you posted as and when we know. We have had a small number of Year 11 students attend today seeking reassurance and we are still welcoming of any who wish to come in for that purpose. Students are clearly anxious about having an opportunity to mark the end of Year 11 and we have already had conversations about an event for the autumn if the Prom is cancelled. Please find below some other information.

GCSE predictions

We have had a few requests for students' GCSE predictions. We were already entering grades for the end of this week so we continue with that process. Given the likely increased importance of these predictions, we will be spending at least a couple of weeks moderating them to ensure accuracy. We will hopefully know tomorrow, Friday, further detail of how qualifications/grades will be awarded. In the meantime you can use the Parent App to see the Year 11 mock results and the previous subject predictions.

Art Coursework

We have received advice from the exam board asking for all work to be handed in, including all coursework and exam preparation sketchbooks. Students should deliver their books to the school reception desk as soon as possible, and by Wednesday, 25 March at the latest.
