Dear Parents and Carers

I hope this email finds you well. I wrote to you last week following the announcement about face to face support for students in years 10 and 12. As yet, no additional guidance has been provided but we have been planning a model which we feel would work at KLB. We are carrying out risk assessments at each stage of our planning and will review as more information is provided.

At this stage, we are looking to open for year 12 students on Thursday 11 June, 25 June and 9 July. On each of these days, there will be a four hour session focusing on one subject, revisiting work set and teaching new content to support the home learning programme. The two week gap between sessions in school is for health and safety reasons.

As you will appreciate, there is a great deal to consider to enable this programme to take place. In order to inform our planning, it would help us if you could complete the form below indicating whether your child is likely to attend these sessions in school.
